How do I donate items to the Resource Center? Food or toiletry items may be dropped off, between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m, Monday through Thursday. Our Family Resource Center is housed at Isaac Dickson Elementary School (125 Hill Street, Asheville NC 28801). Please place donations on the loading dock by the side entrance. There is a designated area for donations marked by a sign.

Please call your child's school between the hours of 8:00 am -4:00 pm, Monday through Thursday and ask to speak with the social worker on duty.
